Ricardo, eight, lives with his drug-addicted mother, his grandmother Donna Maria, as well as uncle, aunt and other relatives in a small house with three rooms: a total of ten people. Only one of them has got a job; the grandmother collects garbage in a wheelbarrow and sells it to help the family.



Ricardo has great difficulties in reading, writing, speaking. He is shy and introverted. In the social centre, employees take care for him and his shortcomings in a special group. Here, all children enjoy participating because they feel understood and accepted. Ricardo also joins in other activities. His family is helped by the social centre, wherever it is possible. With clothes, food and by taking care of Ricardo and two cousins.

# What is it about?

Children and young people in need are taken from the street - away from drug-related crime and violence. They are lovingly cared for, get to know God's love, receive good food, join games and sports activities, and get learning support, various courses and social assistance for the whole family.

In the children's home in Ijuí, Brazil, a big alumni meeting took place in May. A whole three days, former children and staff members as well as their families were able to recall common hours. The joy of reunion was great and it was nice to see how some of the children have continued to develop well.

Children from broken homes, who are left to themselves and often live on the street, find a new and loving home in the children's homes supported by us in Alem, Cotia, Ijuí and Porto. In the families of the homes, they can be children again and are completely cared for.

## Missionary work in Patagonia, southern Argentina

For several years, there has been a small church group in Gan Gan, a village where most of the people belong to the tribe called Mapuche. Their lives are dominated by alcoholism, witchcraft and fortune telling, fear and hopelessness. But Jesus is at work!

Ten years ago, Laureano and Tito died after a drinking contest. Their mothers were inconsolable. Negrita, one of them, came to the missionary activities in the village and accepted Jesus as her personal Saviour. She found refuge and consolation to him. Her younger son came to Christ, too.

Yoly, the other mother, wanted to overcome the depression on her own where she had fallen in. Only when she wasn't able to go on any more, she attended the Christian services. And she found Christ! It was difficult for Yoly to

do the next steps of faith. At her home, it was normal to ask healers and witches. But she grew in faith and was baptized. Today, she is a strong and loyal staff member in Gan Gan.

Last year, Yoly became seriously ill, but she proved an unshakable faith and could be treated successfully. It is a blessing to listen to her, and to feel how strong her confidence in Christ is. In recent years, her daughter, two of her sons and her husband found the Lord. Only Dany, the eldest son, still needs to find Jesus. He hasn't stopped to go to sorcerers and soothsayers yet.

# MANNA - Day care facility **ARGENTINA**

Miriam Pizzi, coordinator of the MANNA projects in the region of Mendoza / Argentina, reports:



We drove to our recent MANNA project in Malargüe, seven hours by car from the city of Mendoza. It is a very poor area, the church is small and all the work is spread over only a few people. Five children are cared for in the MAN-NA programme here. The fates of these children are moving.



We have done everything during our visit, as it would be a huge congregation. We have qualified the staff members for the programme; we have visited the children and talked with the mothers. They were so touched by our visit and we were challenged by God, to give them our love and attention in every minute we had.

One of our MANNA children, Anibal, is seven years old. Both his mother and his stepfather are drug-addicted. We were at their home, but they did not let us in. At the door, they told us how grateful they are for the love that is shown to their son. But the work is going on very slowly, because the circumstances of Anibal's life are anything but normal. We hope that the love of Christ will change these bad conditions.

## What is it about?

Needy children from families with low-income live in "substitute families" from the community during the day. Here, they receive food, medical care, school assistance. The families in charge share God's love, and thereby, MANNA-children and their families get new perspectives of life.

# Mission among the Quechua

Mission Congress - In August, the fifth Mission Congress was held in Jimbe (photo). There were about 200 participants from the surrounding villages. The church in Jimbe had organized the meeting under the leadership of our missionaries Carlota and Hugo Mondoñedo. The atmosphere was filled with joy and gratitude for God's work.



In Rayan, a church building is just being in construction; the clay bricks are manufactured by the church members themselves. In Colcap, the small church house was renovated, so that the services can be held here in the rainy season as well.



Emergency aid (Photo) -In August, there was a very strong winter in Yanaoca and region. The people there live in small and simple mud-walled houses. They don't have any stables for their "pets", mainly sheep, llamas and alpacas, which are their main source of income.

These animals cannot stand the cold, get sick and die if they do not get certain medicaments. Adrián Campero asked for help to support the most affected families. God has made it possible that we could send more than 20,000 EUR for it. More than half of the 1,600 families do not believe. While existential help is brought to these families, the Gospel is being communicated to them as well. So God's love becomes concrete and credible for them. Great gratitude is spreading!

## What is it about?

In the villages of the Andes more and more churches are planted. Many people are given hope through the Gospel; they are experiencing liberation from occult involvement. Even with natural disasters, the missionaries organize help.

Since then, I have been going to the Social Centre with three of my siblings; I was seven years old at that time. Before, I didn't know God, but here I have got to know and love him

above everything else. Every day there are different activities and I am learning a lot. That's better than being on the road and doing wrong things. I thank you for this great idea of setting up such a project; may God bless you. You will always remain in my memory.

Our Cuban brothers and sisters thank God for the great chance to show young people the path to God and to teach them the life of faith. This brings great blessings. Already now, you can see positive changes in their families,

schools and neighbourhoods. How much more will happen when this generation will be grown up, and will have children themselves: that will draw even much wider circles in society!
