Cycling more than 400 Miles for kids in Cuba

In other countries kids live in poverty, have problems because of drugs or become criminal to get a hold of some food and drink. We (Jesse (13) and Eugène (44)) want to take action against this by raising money for a sports-project in Cuba.

In order not just to ask people for money we have decided to do something active by cycling all the way from our hometown (Falkensee, Germany) to the village Heesch in the Netherland. This is a total distance of more than 400 Miles!

The project:

In the project that we want to support, specially educated trainers help kids and youth in the age between 6 and 17 to get rid of their problems. They meet regularly and play several kinds of sports. Some of the teams that are trained are even playing in leagues. Every 2nd month the parents are invited as well and the trainers explain them how to deal best with the issues and problems of the kids when they are at home. This kind of help is so successful that it is being practiced in multiple villages and cities. The enabling charity organization behind this is called EBM International (European Baptist Mission).
