In an article forwarded by our missionary Martin Pusch (North Cameroon), it is reported that over 70 schools in the area bordering on Nigeria had to be shut down due to the threat from the terror group Boko Haram. We are praying for our schools, especially those in Dagai, Gamboura and Mokolo, which keep operating, and we will be pleased about any financial support.



A mere three years ago, Daniel, Larissa and Claudinho lived in the streets and beneath bridges in the slums of Diadema, Brazil, constantly in fear and need. They did not go to school, and were always hungry. Their mother had disappeared, their father lay in some gutter most of the time, under the influence of drugs. These children were taken to the Social Centre in Diadema/Brazil; since then, they have been provided for and cared for in every respect. It is wonderful to see how God's love has transformed them. There are more than 2,000 destitute children who are given help in our various projects in Latin America.



In India, our partner ALMA (led by Rufus Kamalakar) hands out a glass of milk daily and an egg three times a week to 850 children. This helps to prevent malnutrition among the poorest of the poor in the rural areas. The Association of Churches to which this partner belongs has experienced rapid growth for many years.
